- Understanding, training and experience in the area of trauma and trauma-informed practices
- An understanding of colonization, intergenerational trauma, and Indigenous practices; and have direct experience working with Indigenous clients.
- Excellent communication, interpersonal and written skills
- The ability to work both independently and flexibility

A Masters degree (e.g. Psychology, Social Work, Counseling, Marriage and Family Therapy) is required.

The therapist will receive regular supervision.
